## Sample Answers (students' responses may vary)

- 1. The student had been studying all night before falling asleep.
- 2. The soccer player had been running and had been sliding on the wet field.
- 3. The family **had been driving** for hours before they reached the restaurant.
- 4. The dog had been chewing on the shoe.
- 5. The travelers **had been waiting** for a long time before the train arrived.
- 6. The guests **had been singing** "Happy Birthday" before the cake was brought out.

## **Teacher Notes**

- Encourage students to visualize the moment before and describe the action using had been + verb-ing.
- Accept a range of logical answers as long as the tense is correct.
- Extend the task: ask students to draw their own quick sketch of a moment and write what had been happening before.
- This activity links grammar with storytelling and imagination, making the past perfect continuous more meaningful.
