## Sample Answers (students' wording may vary)

- 1. She had been studying for three hours before the exam began.
- 2. They had been playing soccer all afternoon when it started to rain.
- 3. I had been cleaning my room when my mom came home.
- 4. He had been waiting at the bus stop before the bus finally arrived.
- 5. The children had been shouting loudly when the teacher walked in.
- 6. We had been working on the project before the deadline was moved.
- 7. She **had been reading** the novel for days before she finished the last chapter.
- 8. They had been traveling for months before they decided to settle down.
- 9. I had been typing the report for two hours when my computer crashed.
- 10. He **had been practicing** the guitar all morning before his friends came over.

## **Teacher Notes**

- Key structure: Subject + had been + verb-ing + (time phrase) + before/when + event.
- Accept flexible use of **before** or **when** (both correct depending on context).
- Encourage students to notice how the past perfect continuous explains the background/ongoing action, while the simple past describes the interrupting or later event.
- Extension idea: ask students to **create their own pairs** of simple sentences and swap with a partner to combine.
