Sample Journal Responses (students' answers will vary)

Prompt 1: Tired at the end of the day

Teacher Notes

- The goal is for students to embed past perfect continuous naturally in personal writing, not just in isolated drills.
- Require students to underline or highlight the three sentences that use had been + verb-ing.
- Accept a wide range of personal or fictional answers as long as the tense is correct.
- This task blends **grammar with reflective writing**, helping learners see how the tense works in storytelling.
- Extension: Ask students to **share journal entries** in pairs and underline each other's past perfect continuous verbs.
