## **Teacher Notes**

- Key distinction:
  - Past Continuous = was/were + verb-ing → an action in progress at a specific time in the past.
  - o Past Perfect Continuous = had been + verb-ing → an action that started earlier and continued up to another point in the past.
- Encourage students to underline the verb phrases (e.g., was watching, had been studying) to visualize the difference.
- As an extension, ask students to write two original sentences: one in the past continuous and one in the past perfect continuous, then swap with a partner to classify.
