### Teacher Notes

- Key distinction:
  - **Past Continuous = was/were + verb-ing** → an action in progress at a specific time in the past.
  - **Past Perfect Continuous = had been + verb-ing** → an action that started earlier and continued up to another point in the past.
- Encourage students to **underline the verb phrases** (e.g., *was watching*, *had been studying*) to visualize the difference.
- As an extension, ask students to **write two original sentences**: one in the past continuous and one in the past perfect continuous, then swap with a partner to classify.
