Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Tip:** Encourage the use of connecting words (*before, after, by the time, when*) to make sentences smoother.
- Extension Idea: Provide students with a short list of personal events (e.g., "finished breakfast" + "went to school") and have them write about their own day using past perfect.
