## Teacher Notes/Guide

- Common Error: Students may change both verbs to past perfect, but remind them that usually the *earlier action* is past perfect and the *later action* stays in simple past.
- **Tip:** Encourage students to look for signals like *before, after, by the time*; these often cue past perfect.
- Extension Idea: Have students take 3-4 sentences from their own journals or past writing and rewrite them using past perfect for earlier events.
