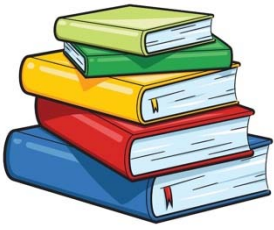

## Past Perfect Conjugations
