1. The line captures a moment of relief and hope as daylight reveals what remains after a night of battle.
2. The stripes and stars stand for unity and freedom; their endurance shows the nation's strength.
3. The flag streaming bravely symbolizes courage and the determination to stand firm.
4. The explosions and light reveal both destruction and proof of resistance and endurance.
5. Seeing the flag "still there" proves survival and symbolizes the nation's perseverance.
6. The question expresses both pride and uncertainty about the nation's ongoing freedom.
7. The final line celebrates America's ideals of liberty, courage, and national pride.

Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

 - **Grades 8-9:** Encourage deeper analysis of historical context and emotional tone.
