Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - **Grades 3-4:** Read the passage aloud and pause for students to fill in each blank together.
 - **Grades 5-6:** Have students write their own short paragraph afterward about a hero in their town.
 - **Grades 7-8:** Challenge students to use each vocabulary word in a new original sentence.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play a short sound clip of emergency sirens before reading to set the scene.
 - Invite local first responders to visit the class or record short thank-you videos.
 - Create a "Hero Wall" displaying students' drawings of firefighters, EMTs, and police.
- **Extension Activities:**
