Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

 - **Grades 9-12:** Have students research a real first responder or soldier and write a personalized letter.
- **Engagement Ideas:**

 - Display letters on a classroom "Wall of Gratitude."
 - Play reflective instrumental music during writing time to set a thoughtful tone.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Turn selected letters into a class book titled "*Letters for Heroes.*"
 - Write a poem about courage inspired by the letter.
 - Have students compare their letters to famous thank-you speeches or historical tributes.
