- 5. Months before December 1941, tensions between Japan and the U.S. grew due to trade restrictions and expanding military actions in Asia.
- 6. Survivors and families later honored the fallen through memorials, ceremonies, and moments of silence each year on Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
