Correct chronological order:

5 → 3 → 2 → 4 → 1 → 6

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Purpose:** Strengthen students' understanding of sequencing and historical cause-and-effect.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For younger students (Grades 4-5), read events aloud and highlight time-related words ("before," "after," "next").
