Teacher's Guide

Quick Tips for Differentiation

- *For developing readers:* Read the passage aloud together, pausing to discuss each blank.
- *For advanced learners:* Have students write one extra sentence summarizing the event using a word from the bank.
- Create multiple rounds: remove the word bank for a challenge variation.

Engagement Ideas

- Brief discussion starter: "Why do you think speaking different languages helped people feel connected?"
- Students draw a small image of one symbol from the passage-wind, flame, dove, etc.

Extension Activities

- Mini-research: Students find one modern example of people working together despite differences.
- Partner retelling: Students pair up and take turns telling the Pentecost event in their own words.
- Vocabulary foldable: Students write each word, its meaning, and an illustration.
