### Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** Teaches students to judge appropriate physical distance in different social settings and relationships.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Read scenarios aloud and have students act them out to demonstrate understanding.
  - Use color codes: green for close, yellow for medium, and blue for far distances.
  - Provide visuals showing examples of spacing between people for students who need visual supports.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Play "Distance Detective" as a movement game where students step to the correct zone labeled on the floor.
  - Discuss how personal space can vary depending on culture, comfort level, and setting.
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Have students write one extra scenario of their own for each distance type.
  - Encourage role-play conversations to practice adjusting personal distance based on who they are talking to.
