Teacher's Guide

- Review the meaning of tenths, hundredths, and thousandths before students begin matching.
- Encourage students to compare one decimal place at a time instead of looking at the whole number at once.
- Provide a place value chart for students who benefit from visual support.
- Have students explain why one match is correct to a partner before checking answers.
- Challenge early finishers to write two new decimals and create matching place value descriptions.
- Extend the activity by asking students to write each decimal in expanded form after completing the matching exercise.
