Teacher's Guide

- Review that numbers farther to the right on a number line have greater values.
- Have students identify the interval between the labeled endpoints before finding the missing decimal.
- Provide a place value chart for students who need extra support naming decimal places.
- Encourage students to explain why a digit is in the tenths or hundredths place using the decimal point as a reference.
- Ask pairs of students to create one additional number line and challenge another pair to solve it.
- Extend the lesson by having students write the value of the highlighted digit after naming its place value.
