

Place Value Mistake Answer Key

1. The 8 is in the hundredths place.
2. The value of 3 is 0.3.
3. The 9 is in the hundredths place.
4. The value of 4 is 0.04.
5. The 0 is in the thousandths place.
6. The value of 8 is 0.008.
7. The 7 is in the thousandths place.
8. The value of 5 is 0.05.
9. The 2 is in the hundredths place.
10. The value of 6 is 0.006.
11. The 1 is in the hundredths place.
12. The value of 9 is 0.9.

Teacher's Guide

- Model one example by locating the decimal point first and counting place values from left to right.
- Encourage students to explain why the original statement is incorrect before writing the correction.
- Provide a place value chart for students who need additional visual support.
- Have partners compare corrections and justify their answers using place value vocabulary.
- Challenge advanced students to create two incorrect statements for classmates to correct.
- Extend the lesson by asking students to write each corrected digit value in expanded form.
