### Teacher's Guide

- Review the order of decimal places before students begin: ones, tenths, hundredths, and thousandths.
- Encourage students to place each digit into the chart first, then write the decimal.
- Remind students that a missing place value is shown with a 0.
- Have students compare answers with a partner and explain how they built each decimal.
- Challenge early finishers to write three sets of place value clues for a classmate to solve.
- Extend learning by asking students to write each completed decimal in word form and expanded form.
