Teacher's Guide

- Explain that strong plot development depends on **logical connections** between events.
- Encourage students to eliminate options that do not add to the sequence or do not logically bridge the two scenes.
- Model a think-aloud: What must happen for Scene 1 to lead naturally to Scene 2?

Differentiation Tips

- Provide a chart with columns labeled "Scene 1," "Possible Middle Event," and "Scene 2" for visual organizers.
- Read choices aloud for students who need support with decoding.
- Let students discuss each question with a partner before selecting an answer.

Engagement Ideas

- Have students write their own Scene 1 and Scene 2, then create four possible middle events for classmates to analyze.
- Turn the worksheet into a game where groups defend their chosen answer using evidence from the scenes.
- Ask students to act out the correct middle event to reinforce understanding.
