

South Pole Keywords Answer Key

Possible Keyword Triggers:

- **Paragraph 1:** *Explorers* - reminds students the passage is about the people seeking the South Pole.
- **Paragraph 2:** *Preparation* - highlights the contrast between Amundsen's dogs and Scott's failing equipment.
- **Paragraph 3:** *Outcome* - recalls who succeeded (Amundsen) and who struggled (Scott).
- **Paragraph 4:** *Legacy* - connects the lesson of planning and courage to the broader meaning of the race.

Explanation for Teachers:

- Students may choose different keywords (e.g., *Pole, Dogs, Tragedy, Courage*), but they should justify each choice.
- The goal is to practice **linking a single keyword with a memory hook** to recall a whole section.
- Extension: Have students cover the passage and retell it aloud using only their four keywords as prompts.
