

Water Rhymes Flow Answer Key

Key Main Ideas to Remember:

- Evaporation = water heated into vapor.
- Condensation = vapor turns into clouds.
- Precipitation = rain or snow falls.
- The water cycle sustains life.

Sample Rhymes:

- *“When water’s hot, it leaves the pot—evaporation starts the plot.”*
- *“Vapor chills, cloud forms still—condensation builds the fill.”*
- *“Rain comes down, drops hit the ground—precipitation’s all around.”*
- *“Cycle goes on, dusk till dawn—life depends, it won’t be gone.”*

Teacher Notes:

- Students’ rhymes will vary; accuracy matters more than rhyme quality.
- Encourage **simple patterns** (AABB or ABAB) so the rhythm helps memory.
- Extension: Have students perform their rhymes aloud as a chant or song for added recall practice.
