

Amazon Alliteration Answer Key

Key Main Ideas to Remember:

- Amazon = “lungs of the Earth,” produces oxygen.
- Home to millions of species (biodiversity).
- Helps regulate climate by absorbing carbon dioxide.
- Indigenous people rely on resources.
- Deforestation threatens rainforest.
- Protection is essential.

Sample Alliterative Phrases:

- “*Amazon air awakens*” → reminds students it produces oxygen for Earth.
- “*Species survive, spread, and soar*” → highlights the biodiversity.
- “*Carbon capture controls climate*” → links to regulation of global climate.
- “*People preserve plants*” → connects to Indigenous reliance and conservation.
- “*Deforestation destroys diversity*” → stresses the threat to species.

Teacher Notes:

- Students' alliterations will vary; the goal is meaningful **sound repetition** tied to the text.
- Encourage students to make their phrases **short and catchy**, like slogans, so they stick in memory.
- Extension: Have students combine their alliterative phrases into a short chant or poster to reinforce recall.
