The First Moon Landing

In July 1969, NASA achieved a historic milestone by landing astronauts on the Moon. The spacecraft Apollo 11 carried three astronauts: Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin, and Michael Collins. Armstrong and Aldrin descended to the lunar surface while Collins remained in orbit. Armstrong became the first human to step onto the Moon, saying his famous words, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind." The astronauts collected rock samples, took photographs, and planted the American flag. Millions of people around the world watched the event on television. After their mission, the astronauts safely returned to Earth, completing one of humanity's greatest achievements.
