Themes At Twilight Answer Key

Q1. Possible Theme Statements:

- The poem's theme is about the enduring strength of memory and connection across time.
- Another acceptable theme: Even as life changes and time passes, faithful structures and bonds can guide us forward.

Q2. Supporting lines:

- "Each step echoes like a memory." (memory and continuity)
- "Though shadows lengthen, the bridge still stands." (endurance and guidance)

Q3. Extension:

 The theme applies today by reminding us that relationships, traditions, or history can guide us through difficult times, just like the bridge guides travelers through the dusk.

Teacher Notes:
