Venn Diagram Example:

Lena's Perspective	Both	Marcus's Perspective
Excited, bouncing on her toes, "This is going to be amazing!"	Both are at the roller coaster line; both notice the tall ride; both reacting to the same event.	Nervous, frowning, "It looks terrifying," arms crossed, hesitant.

Teacher Notes/Guide

- This worksheet trains students to recognize **multiple viewpoints** within the same text.
- Encourage students to **cite textual evidence** ("What words show Lena's excitement?").
- The Venn diagram makes abstract ideas **visual and organized**.
