Limited or All-Knowing Answer Key

- 1. **Omniscient** reveals Ella's nervous thoughts *and* Mr. Davis's hopes.
- 2. **Limited** shows only Marcus's inner thoughts.
- 3. Omniscient reveals Naomi's thoughts and her mother's feelings.
- 4. **Limited** shows only Jordan's feelings; others' thoughts are not revealed.
- 5. **Omniscient** reveals Maya's worries, Max's confidence, and the teacher's amusement.

Teacher Notes/Guide

- Students often confuse actions with thoughts. Clarify that actions (cheering, frowning, smiling) do not reveal inner perspective unless paired with thought words.
- A good strategy: Highlight every thought/feeling clue in a passage, then count how many characters' minds are opened.
- Limited = one mind. Omniscient = two or more.
- For more advanced students, you may suggest this extension task: Write a
 short passage (3-4 sentences) that shows a limited narrator. Then, rewrite it
 as if the narrator were omniscient. This helps students practice switching
 narration styles, deepening understanding of author's choices.
