Multiple Voices Chart (Sample):

| Character | What They See/Do | What They Think/Feel |
|-----------|-------------------------|---|
| Maya | Adjusts volcano project | Nervous, hopes it will erupt correctly |
| Jamal | Looks at solar car | Confident, convinced he will win |
| Mrs. Lee | Watches the students | Proud, thinks all projects are creative |

Questions (Model Answers)

1. Maya is **nervous and unsure**, while Jamal is **confident and certain** he will win.
2. Mrs. Lee sees the **whole fair** and feels **pride**, while the students focus only on their own projects and competition.
3. The author shows multiple voices to **highlight different perspectives** of the same event, making the story richer and showing contrast in emotions.

Teacher Notes/Guide

- Encourage students to **underline clue words** like *hoping*, *convinced*, *proudly* that reveal inner thoughts.
- Remind them: different characters can be in the **same scene** but experience it in very different ways.
- Differentiation tip: For advanced students, ask them to explain how showing multiple voices changes the **reader's understanding** of the event.
