Narrator's Voice Answer Key

1. **First-Person Narrator** - the speaker uses *I* to tell their own story.
2. **Second-Person Narrator** - narrator addresses the reader directly with *you*.
3. **Third-Person Narrator** - outside narrator describing *Jamal*.
4. **Character's Perspective (Dialogue)** - Carla is speaking inside the story.
5. **First-Person Narrator** - uses *we* to include the narrator as part of the story.
6. **Third-Person Narrator** - outside narrator telling about *he*.

Teacher Notes/Guide

- Students may confuse **dialogue** with first-person narration. Remind them: **dialogue is enclosed in quotation marks and tied to a character's speech**, not the narrator.
- Encourage students to underline or highlight pronouns in each quote as **clue words**.
- Differentiation idea: Provide a short passage with **multiple perspectives** and ask advanced students to identify shifts in narration.
