Teacher's Guide

Purpose

- Introduces major Polish landmarks in a simple, engaging format suitable for grades 3 to 5.
- Builds recognition of key physical and cultural features of Poland.

Differentiation Tips

- Read questions aloud for students who need additional support.
- Allow advanced learners to write a short fact about each landmark after choosing an answer.

Engagement Ideas

- Show photos of the Tatra Mountains, Wawel Castle, and the Baltic Coast and have students guess the name before revealing it.
- Use short landmark trivia rounds as warm ups or cool downs.

Extension Activities

- Students choose one landmark and write three facts about it.
- Assign partner research on a lesser known Polish landmark.
- Have students design a postcard themed around one of the landmarks in the quiz.
