- 4. Loud fireworks blasting in the middle of the night.
- 5. Smoke from wildfires spreading through the atmosphere.
- 6. Plastic bottles floating down a river.
- 7. Heavy construction equipment making constant loud noises.
- 8. Farmers using too much pesticide, which poisons farmland.
- 9. Jets flying overhead producing loud roaring sounds.
- 10. Burning coal at a power plant releasing sulfur dioxide.
- 11. Factories dumping waste into lakes.
- 12. A concert with speakers blasting music for miles.
- 13. Acid rain soaking into the soil.
- 14. Trash buried in landfills leaking into underground water.
