Impact of Water Pollution Answer Key

- 1. The river (freshwater resource) was most affected.
- 2. Pollution harmed fish (they became sick and fewer were found) and harmed people (caused stomach problems).
- The crops stopped growing well because polluted water used for irrigation carried harmful chemicals.
- 4. The townspeople organized meetings, contacted officials, and demanded factories treat their waste.
- 5. The lesson is that human actions can damage the environment, but communities can work together to protect and restore it.
