Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students will identify words with prefixes in context and practice reading comprehension using applied vocabulary understanding.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Pre-teach common prefixes (re-, un-, dis-, in-, etc.) using examples before reading.
 - Challenge advanced students to define each prefix word in their own words.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the passage into a "Prefix Safari" scavenger hunt by hiding extra prefix words around the classroom.
 - Have students dramatize Jenna's problem-solving to build reading fluency and engagement.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Ask students to write their own short paragraph with at least five prefix words.
 - Use the paragraph for a mini grammar study on how prefixes change meaning and part of speech.
