

Word Fusion Workshop Answer Key

1. **Rebuild** - to build again
2. **Unwrap** - to remove the wrapping
3. **Preheat** - to heat before use
4. **Misspell** - to spell something incorrectly
5. **Disconnect** - to separate or remove a connection
6. **Overcook** - to cook too long or too much
7. **Submarine** - a vessel that operates under the sea
8. **Interact** - to act or communicate with others
9. **Transport** - to carry or move from one place to another
10. **Nonstop** - without stopping or breaks

Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students will practice forming words by combining prefixes with root words and deepen their understanding of how prefixes alter word meanings.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger students, read the prefixes aloud and discuss what each means before combining.
 - Challenge advanced learners to use each new word in an original sentence.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "Prefix Factory" in class where students "assemble" new words and share their meanings aloud.
 - Have pairs act out their new words for classmates to guess (e.g., "unwrap" could be mimed).
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Ask students to find more examples of each prefix in books or around the classroom.
 - Encourage writing a short paragraph using at least three of their newly formed words to reinforce comprehension and context use.
