Teacher's Guide

• **Objective:** Students will form antonyms by adding prefixes and understand how prefixes reverse or change word meanings.

• Differentiation Tips:

- Review each prefix's meaning before starting: un- (not), dis-(opposite of), in-/im- (not).
- Allow struggling students to use prefix flashcards for matching practice.
- Encourage advanced students to write sentences using both the base and new words (e.g., fair / unfair).

• Engagement Ideas:

- Turn it into a "Prefix Magic Show" where students "transform" base words by waving a pretend wand and saying the new word aloud.
- Use a class prefix wall with examples to reinforce ongoing learning.

• Extension Ideas:

- Have students brainstorm other prefixes that create opposites (like iror non-).
