- hot → cold
- warm → cool
- cold → hot

Teacher Notes/Guide

- Read the story slowly, emphasizing the opposite pairs (**hot/cold**, **warm/cool**).
- Act out the story for better understanding (pretend to blow on soup, pretend to shiver eating ice cream).
- Guide children by asking: "If soup is hot, what is the opposite?"
- Preschoolers may at first match by guessing. Reinforce by revisiting the story and pointing to the details.
- This activity strengthens **vocabulary**, introduces the concept of **opposites**, and builds **listening comprehension** in a playful way.
