Teacher Notes

- **Focus Point:** Students practice systematic conjugation of verbs in the **present continuous tense**, reinforcing subject–verb agreement.
- **Spelling Reminder:** Emphasize spelling changes when adding *-ing* (e.g., *write* → *writing*, *run* → *running* with double consonant).
- **Differentiation Tip:** Ask advanced students to create a sentence for each conjugated form (e.g., “*I am writing a story*”).
- **Extension Idea:** Provide different verbs (e.g., *swim*, *dance*, *read*, *cook*) for students to fill in as extra practice or homework.
