Teacher Notes

- Differentiation Tip: Encourage stronger students to rewrite the same sentences as questions after making them negative (e.g., Is she reading a book?).
- Extension Idea: In pairs, students can create two positive sentences and swap them with a partner, who must rewrite them in the negative form.
