## Scene In Motion Answer Key

### At the Park

- The children are playing tag near the playground.

### At School

### Teacher Notes

- **Focus Point:** This worksheet encourages students to use the **present continuous tense** in **extended writing**, moving beyond single sentences.
- **Differentiation Tip:** For beginners, provide a **word bank** (e.g., cooking, reading, playing, running, writing, watching). For advanced learners, encourage them to add **details** (adverbs, time markers, or reasons).
- **Extension Idea:** Have students read their mini-stories aloud. Classmates can ask **Wh- questions** about the stories (e.g., *Who is cooking dinner?*).
- **Common Errors:** Students may forget auxiliary verbs (e.g., *She cooking dinner*). Remind them that the structure is **am/is/are + verb-ing**.
