

Making Questions Answer Key

1. Is the teacher explaining the lesson?
2. Are the students writing in their notebooks?
3. Are you talking too loudly?
4. Am I wearing my uniform today?
5. Is she drawing a picture of a tree?
6. Are they studying for the science test?
7. Is he running in the park?
8. Are we practicing our play?
9. Is the cat sleeping on the sofa?
10. Am I listening to music?

Teacher Notes

- **Focus Point:** Students practice moving *am/is/are* to the beginning of a sentence to form Yes/No questions in the **present continuous tense**.
- **Common Mistakes:** Students may forget to keep the -ing form of the verb (e.g., *Is she read?* instead of *Is she reading?*). Emphasize that only the auxiliary verb changes position.
- **Extension Idea:** Have students pair up. One asks a Yes/No question from the worksheet, and the partner answers with "Yes, he/she/they are" or "No, he/she/they aren't."
- **Challenge Task:** Ask students to create **two of their own statements** and rewrite them as Yes/No questions.
