## **Teacher Notes:**

- Formula reminder: Question word + has/have + subject + been + verb(-ing).

- Point out that time markers (for, since, all afternoon, lately) often go with present perfect continuous.
- Extension: Have students walk around the class in a "Reporter Role-Play," asking classmates the questions and writing short answers.
