News In Progress Answer Key

Sample Answers (students' wording may vary but must use present perfect continuous):

1. Sarah **has been interviewing** teachers about upcoming events.
2. Liam and Emma **have been designing** the layout for the pages.
3. The students **have been taking** photos during sports games and assemblies.
4. Mr. James **has been checking** articles and **giving** feedback.
5. The team **has been staying** late after school.
6. Everyone **has been working** hard to prepare for the deadline.

Teacher Notes:

- Ensure students **answer in full sentences**, not just fragments.
- Emphasize the structure: **has/have + been + verb(-ing)**.
- Point out that this activity practices both **reading comprehension** and **tense production**.
- Extension: Ask students to write **two more questions** about the passage and have a partner answer them using the present perfect continuous.
