Teacher's Notes

- **Common Issues:** Students often mix up **has/have** or forget to use the past participle form (e.g., *have went* instead of *have gone*).

- **Differentiation:** Stronger students can create two new dialogues using irregular verbs in the present perfect.
- **Cultural Connection:** Use *ever/never*, *already*, *yet*, *just* to show how the tense expresses experiences and recent events.
