Never Have I Ever Answer Key

Highlighted Verbs (with *ever/never*)

- has **never** traveled
- has **ever** dreamed
- has **never** tried
- has **never** ridden
- has **never** played
- has **ever** taken
- has **never** been (to the beach)
- has **never** seen
- has **ever** built
- has **never** flown
- has **never** been (afraid)

Comprehension Answers

1. Tom has never traveled outside his country, never tried sushi, and never ridden a horse.
2. Sarah has ever taken part in a dance competition.
3. Diego has never seen snow.
4. Sarah has never been to the beach.
5. Tom has never tried sushi, while Sarah has never played video games.

Teacher's Notes

- **Important Clarification:** In natural English, *ever* is usually used in **questions** (e.g., *Have you ever...?*), and rarely in positive sentences. However, this worksheet uses it in **statements** to create contrastive practice with *never* for clarity and reinforcement. Teachers may wish to note this distinction to advanced learners.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to write 3 sentences about themselves using *never* and 1 question for a classmate using *ever*. Example: *I have never eaten octopus. / Have you ever eaten octopus?*
- **Differentiation:** Stronger students can add details to the passage (new hobbies, foods, or trips) and rewrite with *ever/never*.
