## Present Perfect Fixes Answer Key

1. She **has eaten** breakfast already.
2. I **have finished** my homework.
3. They **have gone** to the park twice this week.
4. We **haven't seen** that movie yet.
5. He **has driven** his car to work today.
6. Maria **has written** three stories.
7. I **have never seen** the Northern Lights.
8. They **have played** soccer since they **were** kids.
9. We **have eaten** lunch just now.
10. He **has been** my friend for many years.

### Teacher's Notes

- **Common Issues:** Students often mix **simple past** and **present perfect**, especially with irregular verbs (*eat* → *eaten*, *go* → *gone*, *see* → *seen*).
- **Tip:** Emphasize that **have/has + past participle** is the correct form, not the past simple.
- **Extension:** After correcting, ask students to write 2 original sentences with irregular verbs in present perfect, then trade with a partner for peer-checking.
- **Differentiation:** Stronger students can expand corrections by adding adverbs like *already*, *just*, *yet*, *ever*, *never* for richer practice.
