Differentiation Tips

- Provide sentence starters for younger writers
 - *"I am writing to you because..."*
 - *"One issue that is important to me is..."*
- Allow students to brainstorm issues in small groups first
- Offer vocabulary supports: **community**, **responsibility**, **fairness**, **improvement**, **leadership**

Engagement Ideas

- Set up a "White House Mailbox" display for finished letters
- Allow students to role-play "presidential responses"
- Encourage illustrations for Grades 3-4 (students draw the president or their idea)
