### Teacher's Guide

#### Skill Focus

- Understanding **government and leadership** vocabulary
- Presidents Day content connection
- Word-definition comprehension

#### Differentiation Tips

- Provide picture cues for younger learners (e.g., a ballot box for democracy)
- Allow oral matching or pointing for emerging readers
- Use color-coding (words one color, definitions another) for visual support

#### Engagement Ideas

- Quick class game: students act out a word (e.g., "veto" with a thumbs-down)
- Create a "Presidential Word Wall" with illustrations or examples
- Partner matching: each student gets a card and must find their match

#### Extension Activities

- Students write their own sentence using 2-3 vocabulary words
- Add 3 more government terms for advanced groups (e.g., **term, Supreme Court, ballot**)
- Connect to current events: students identify examples of these words in the news
