Quote Vs. Summary Answer Key

1. **P** - Direct quote from Goodall = Primary.
2. **S** - Paraphrased explanation from narrator = Secondary.
3. **S** - Magazine article summarizing her influence = Secondary.
4. **P** - Transcript of her own speech = Primary.
5. **S** - Documentary summary = Secondary.

Teacher's Notes:

- Reinforce that **direct quotes and original words** from a person count as **primary**.
- Emphasize that **summaries, explanations, or retellings** by another author or narrator are **secondary**.
- Some students may confuse speeches with summaries; remind them that **the speech itself** is a primary source, but an article *about* the speech would be secondary.
- Extension idea: Have students create two examples of their own: one direct quote and one summary about the same topic, then swap with a partner to identify.
