### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Read scenarios aloud and discuss key words that show if help is needed.
  - Provide picture cards labeled *Problem* and *No Problem* for visual learners.
  - Allow group or partner discussion before writing answers.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have students act out each situation and vote as a class on their answers.
  - Use a "Problem or No Problem?" corner where students practice sorting examples.
  - Connect answers to real-life classroom or playground experiences.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Ask students to write one new scenario of their own and swap with a partner.
  - Encourage journaling: "What is one small problem I solved today?"
  - Create a "Calm Choices" poster showing what to do when a real problem happens.
