Problem-Solution Chain Answer Key

Problem Chain Chart

- 1. Problem: The poster blew away, and no one would know where to go. Solution: Teacher made a new sign and hung it at the entrance.
- 2. Problem: The microphone broke, so people couldn't hear the announcements.
 - Solution: Students borrowed the music teacher's portable speaker.
- 3. Problem: The prize table collapsed, scattering toys and candy. Solution: Parents set up a stronger table and reorganized the prizes.

Extension (Sample Answer):

Solving each problem kept the fair running smoothly. If the poster, microphone, or table hadn't been fixed, the event would have failed. Step-by-step solutions show how teamwork and problem-solving prevent small problems from becoming bigger ones.

Teacher Notes:

- Emphasize that each **problem caused a new challenge**, forming a chain.
- Have students draw arrows between problems and solutions to visualize the "chain."
- For enrichment: Ask students to add an imaginary next problem and create a solution for it.
